Green Mountain Maple, <i>Acer saccharum 'Green Mountain'</i> : Rounded crown; 70'height/40' spread at maturity; tolerant of drought where space is not limiting; resistant to leaf tatter	1 3/4"		\$95		\$
Legacy Maple, <i>Acer saccharum 'Legacy'</i> : Oval crown; 50' height/35' spread at maturity; tolerant of dry soils when space is not limiting; resistant to leaf tatter	1 3/4"		\$95		\$
<b>Dogwood</b>					
Cherokee Brave Dogwood, <i>Cornus florida 'Cherokee Brave'</i> : Small understory tree; 25' height/22" spread at maturity; flowers are red to dark pink with white center; disease resistant and hardy; prefers well-drained soils.	1 1/4"		\$65		\$
<b>Hawthorn</b>					
Winter King Hawthorn, <i>Crataegus viridis 'Winter King'</i> : Rounded-vase shaped crown; 20' height/25' spread at maturity; large white flowers, small orange-red fruit, dark glossy green leaves turn bronze/red/gold; bark peels off in sections reveal orange bark; few thorns; good drainage, full sun; moderately difficult to survive as bare-root	1 3/4"		\$74		\$
Thornless Cockspur Hawthorn, <i>Crataegus crus-galli var. inermis</i> : Rounded-spreading crown; 15' height/20' spread at maturity; glossy leaves, white flowers, red fruit; requires good drainage and full sun; moderately difficult to survive as bare-root	1 3/4"		\$87		\$
<b>Tuliptree</b>					
Yellow or Tulip Poplar, <i>Liriodendron tulipifera</i> ; Tall tree with straight trunk; pyramidal crown; 70' height/ 40' spread at maturity; large, rapidly-growing tree that grows to dominance in the forest canopy; flowers and leaves resemble tulips	1 1/2"		\$85		\$

Imperial Honeylocust, <i>Gleditsia tricanthos</i> var. <i>inermis</i> 'Imperial': Round crown; 35' height/35' spread at maturity; adapts well to a variety of soil conditions; thornless with few seed pods	1 3/4"		\$88		\$
Shademaster Honeylocust, <i>Gleditsia tricanthos</i> var. <i>inermis</i> 'Shademaster': Wide-spreading crown; 45' height/35' spread at maturity; adapts well to a variety of soil conditions; thornless with few seed pods	1 1/2"		\$77		\$
Skyline Honeylocust, <i>Gleditsia tricanthos</i> var. <i>inermis</i> 'Skyline': Broadly-pyramidal crown, central leader with ascending branches; 45' height/35' spread at maturity; adapts well to a variety of soil conditions; thornless with few seed pods	1 3/4"		\$88		\$
Sunburst Honeylocust, <i>Gleditsia tricanthos</i> var. <i>inermis</i> 'Sunburst': Irregularly-rounded crown; 35' height/30' spread at maturity; adapts well to a variety of soil conditions; thornless with few seed pods; spring leaves are yellow changing to green in summer	1 3/4"		\$88		\$
<b>Red Oak</b>					
Red Oak, <i>Quercus rubra</i> ; Produces acorns; broadly-pyramidal crown; 75' height/60' spread at maturity; large, slow-growing tree that grows to dominance in the forest canopy	1 3/4"		\$104		\$
<b>Linden/Basswood</b>					
Redmond Linden or American Basswood, <i>Tilia americana</i> 'Redmond': Pyramidal crown; 50' height, 30' spread at maturity; glossy foliage turning bright yellow in fall; flowers in abundant clusters of light yellow blooms	1 3/4"		\$88		\$
<b>Viburnum</b>					
Nannyberry Viburnum, <i>Viburnum lentago</i> :	1.25"		\$56		\$

Payment is due with your order, payable to HFCA because HFCA must submit a community order to NEPA Tree Association.*

DELIVERY OF TREES WILL BE IN THE SPRING (MID APRIL TO EARLY MAY) ON A DAY TO BE ANNOUNCED. YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR PICKING UP YOUR TREE(S) AT THE PUBLIC WORKS FACILITY ON DELIVERY DAY. CHOOSE YOUR PLANTING SITE CAREFULLY. WE RECOMMEND PREPARING THE PLANTING SITE PRIOR TO DELIVERY AND PLANTING YOUR TREE THE SAME DAY OF DELIVERY. AFTER PLANTING, YOUR TREES MUST BE WATERED ONCE A WEEK WITH A MINIMUM OF 10 GALLONS OF SLOW, DEEP, THOROUGH WATERING (HOSE ON SLOW FOR ABOUT 2 HOURS).
