## Camper Packet

Dear Parents,

On behalf of the staff, I would like to welcome you and your child to the Fawn Hill Day Camp. I am anticipating a wonderful summer full of fun and adventure. Please take the time to carefully review the following information:

1. **Please be sure to read all of the enclosed materials in the camper packet** so you are well informed of the daily camper check list, policy changes, drop off and pick up procedures, rainy day plans, camper responsibilities and code of conduct, the calendar of events for this summer (subject to change), and movie preference form (please fill out and return to your child's supervisor ASAP).
2. In order for us to administer any kind of medication to your child, you first must;
  - a. Fill out the medical portion of the registration form.
  - b. Provide us with a signed note giving us permission to administer meds to your child.
  - c. The medication must be clearly labeled with your child's name and directions for administration.
  - d. All the above must be in our possession on the first day your child attends camp.
3. We suggest that your son/daughter wear his/her camp T-shirt every day. This helps us easily distinguish our campers from other children, **which is especially important on field trips.**

I would like to thank you in advance for all your help and cooperation. I am looking forward to seeing you the first day of Summer Day Camp on June 28th!

# Daily Camper Check List

- ☺ **Sneakers for athletic activity (required)**
- ☺ **Medication labeled with name & administration instructions, accompanied with a signed permission note**
- ☺ **Please provide a bag lunch & drink**
- ☺ **Water bottle labeled with child's name (important especially for hot days)**
- ☺ **Towel, bathing suit, & sun screen**
- ☺ **Tennis racquet for tennis days**
- ☺ **Outing permission slips (with cash payment only)**

**Please label all belongings (including backpacks) and please do not send valuables or large amounts of money with your child.**

**We are not responsible for any lost or stolen items.**

# Camp Policies

## Maximum Enrollment:

We are thrilled in the community's interest to send their children to Fawn Hill Day Camp! The popularity of this program warrants a maximum number of children able to enroll for any given week. It is important to us to ensure the safety of your child and maintain smooth operations of camp.

Therefore, **on time registration** the Friday before camp begins will be implemented. Once we hit an overall enrollment of 165 campers, we will have to turn people away.

No exceptions will be made since we are restricted by child to staff ratios required by law.

## Camp Level Assignment – Please note change:

If your child's birthday is between June 28th and August 13th, AND he/she is of eligible age to advance into the next camp level they will be permitted to do so. *However, once a child moves up a camp level, they will not be allowed to move back down. **This decision will be final.*** Please discuss this with your child before moving them up a camp level.

## **Please note the following camper packet changes as of 2010:**

- **Snack bar purchases will be limited to lunchtime only.**
- **No cell phones, ipods or electric devices allowed in camp except during trips.**
- **Please make sure you hand in a signed permission slip for each camper.**
- **Trips must be paid in full the day prior. NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE! This will ensure our prompt departure on the morning of the trip. If your child is not going on the trip but still attending camp for the day, please inform the supervisor.**
- **Trip permission slip packets will be available in the office on April 12<sup>th</sup>. Please don't forget to pick one up.**

# Pick up & Drop off Procedures

- Please escort your child to and from the Fawn Hill Pavilion to ensure their whereabouts and safety.
- Late campers up to 10:00 am - follow the above procedures and please make sure to check your child in with a supervisor.
- At the end of the camp day, please make sure to sign your child out with a counselor before leaving.

## Fawn Hill Day Camp Camper Responsibilities and Code of Conduct

Before attending camp, I ask that you please spend some time discussing the following responsibilities and code of conduct with your child. I wish to thank you in advance for your understanding and cooperation.

Depending on the severity of the violation, the following, per the discretion of the camp director, are grounds for a phone call home, dismissal from camp for one day, or suspension from camp without refund. **ALL OF THE FOLLOWING WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.**

1. Disrespect, profanity, harassment, or assaulting/bullying another camper or staff member
2. Misuse or abuse of public or personal property
3. Gambling, trading or stealing of any kind
4. Possession or use of illegal drugs (including tobacco), or alcoholic beverages is strictly prohibited
5. Possession of firearms or other weapons is strictly prohibited
6. Leaving camp before signing out with a counselor
7. Consistent late arrival after 10:00 a.m.
8. Any clothing that exposes mid drifts and undergarments. Sneakers are required!

Please remember, children between the ages of 4-15 attend camp and we need to be considerate of each other. In addition, Fawn Hill Day Camp is **not responsible for any lost or stolen items.**
